

Hospitality: Adrenalites Cook

# Purpose of Role

Adrenalites cooks help facilitate the ministry of making disciples of the children at Adrenalites by cooking and serving dinner for the children and leaders to eat together.

## The role in practice

- Shopping for ingredients for the meal (using the OEC account at Woolworths)
- Following the allocated simple recipe to cook dinner for approximately 70 people.
- Either cooking at home and transporting the meal to the OEC Ministry Centre; or using the OEC kitchen facilities to cook dinner.
- Serving the meal (at approximately 6:30pm) to the children and leaders of Adrenalites.
- Working with Adrenalites leaders and a rostered Adrenalites kitchen helper to wash up and clean up after dinner.

## **Required training:**

- Complete the online NSW Food Authority *"Food handler basics"* training (approximately 1 hour), and provide completion certificate to the OEC office.
- New cooks will be rostered with an experienced cook to provide on the job instruction and training.

### Commitment:

- This is a rostered position. Cooks are rostered on once per school term.
- Adrenalites cooks are rostered through Elvanto. You may submit unavailability in advance and/or organize to swap with someone else on the roster if you need to make a change.
