Commit to growing in Christlikeness, pursuing habits of personal bible reading and prayer. They participate in the life of OEC by regularly attending church and are part of a Growth Group.



Share our high value on serving in a team. God made us for rich relationships, and we are more effective as we work together. Joining a team means being committed to its vision, being prayerful and faithful in fulfilling your role and to care for the other team members as you serve. Team members attend planning and training meetings.



Commit to being wise and careful towards everyone you serve. Our safe ministry policies are very important to read and practice.

A key part of the team leaders' role is to support you. You can expect they will take time to address any concerns, to equip and walk alongside you as you serve.

SERVINGBOOKLET

This booklet outlines the five main areas that make up the life of our church. In each area there are teams of people serving Jesus and his people. In the booklet there is a short description for each team, including the current need, when you can start serving and if the role is suitable for teens (see the symbols below).

Further information on every team can be found in the position descriptions on the website. These include the time commitment and expectations for each team. Some have a higher commitment. To serve in these teams it is wise not to over commit by serving in other teams.

Share Christ with adults with intellectual disabilities so they can know him and live as his disciples or support the team by providing supper.



Evangelism Team

Work congregationally to build evangelistic heat. Meet quarterly to assess and improve how OEC as a whole is sharing the gospel.



Mission Support Team

Ensure our mission partners receive the support they need and help members of OEC engage with mission.



Easter Family Festival

Be involved in the biggest inter-church event in Orange by running stalls and using organisational skills.



Community Food Support Team

Cook meals to be shared with our wider community as a demonstration of God's kindness towards vulnerable people.



Aged Care Visitors Team

Show Christ's love to elderly people who are experiencing loneliness in our community by providing connection and friendship.



Disaster Response Team

Assist with practical needs and care following a community crisis.

Write 200 word articles aimed at piquing interest in the gospel.

OEC Special Events

Organise catering, set up, service and clean up for special OEC or ministry occasional events.

KIDSE YOUTH


