Disaster Response Team Member

Purpose of the Role

The Disaster Response team member plays an important role in supporting OECs response to a crisis (eg natural disaster) in our community and its surrounds. He/she will be guided by the Disaster Relief Team Leader (DRTL) to respond to needs that are identified.

Character and Competence Expectations

The team member will be someone who shares God's deep concern for human suffering and respond with compassion by being willing to serve those in need.

The role in practice

There are no specific skill requirements to be a team member. He/she will be willing to work within a team, under the guidance of the team leader. If a volunteer has specific skills (eg administration) these may be utilised, depending on what is needed.

Examples of tasks may include food distribution or transporting any donated goods to a site.

Youth (aged 15+) are welcome to do some tasks (eg food distribution) with parental permission.

Training

Training will occur on the job.
