

Sunday Hospitality Team: Morning Tea/Afternoon Tea

# Purpose of Role

The team provides food and drink to facilitate conversations and fellowship after our Sunday congregations.

## The role in practice

- Purchase/prepare the food before the day.
- Set up the tables and chairs in the breakout space.
- Set up the serving areas (adults and children).
- Serve or supervise the distribution of food and drinks.
- Clean up afterwards to help the next group.

## **Required training**

- Highly recommended: Complete the online NSW Food Authority *"Food handler basics"* training (approximately 1 hour), and provide completion certificate to the OEC office.
- New team members will be rostered with an experienced team member to provide on the job instruction and training.

## Commitment

- This is different in each congregation.
- It is often 2 weeks per term in teams of 3 (including 1 for children's food).

## What will happen next?

You will be rostered in Elvanto to serve. The OEC Office will provide you with any further information, including how to indicate your availability in Elvanto.
