



Adrenalites Dinner Team

Purpose of Role

Adrenalites cooks help facilitate the ministry of making disciples of the children at Adrenalites by cooking and serving dinner for the children and leaders to eat together.

The role in practice

- Shopping for ingredients for the meal (using the OEC account at Woolworths)
- Following the allocated simple recipe to cook dinner for approximately 90 people.
- Either cooking at home and transporting the meal to the OEC Ministry Centre; or using the OEC kitchen facilities to cook dinner.
- Serving the meal (at approximately 6:30pm) to the children and leaders of Adrenalites.
- Working with Adrenalites leaders and a rostered Adrenalites kitchen helper to wash up and clean up after dinner.

Required training:

- Complete the online NSW Food Authority “*Food handler basics*” training (approximately 1 hour), and provide completion certificate to the OEC office.
- New cooks will be rostered with an experienced cook to provide on the job instruction and training.

Commitment:

- This is a rostered position. Cooks are rostered on once per school term.
- Adrenalites cooks are rostered through Elvanto. You may submit unavailability in advance and/or organize to swap with someone else on the roster if you need to make a change.
