Purpose

KidZone seeks to reach out to the children of Orange with the good news of Jesus through a school-holiday Kids Club during the Easter school holidays (13 - 16 April 2026). KidZone caters for children in Kindergarten to Year 6 at school and provides an opportunity for the children of OEC to bring their friends to hear the gospel clearly explained in a fun and engaging way, whilst building connections with the community of Orange.

The role in practice

The Support Team at KidZone is a valuable team that helps with a variety of different roles. Some of these roles include assisting with catering (morning teas), running a coffee cart to enable connection with non-Christian parents, managing the registrations and signing children into the program each day, helping with the preparation of decorations or craft, leading music, involvement in daily dramas or puppetry, running a variety of fun recreational activities (such as sports activities or crafts) on one or more of the afternoons of KidZone, helping with AV, and so much more.

Required training

- All roles that involve direct interaction with children will require an up-to-date WWCC and Safe Ministry Training.
- Other training will be provided as needed depending on the role.

Commitment

The level of commitment will vary depending on the role(s) you volunteer for. There are jobs that require attendance at KidZone, and others that can be done in a time that suits in the leadup to KidZone.
