



Play-Pals

Purpose of Role

A Play-Pals helper cares for the pre-school children (over 1 year old) of women involved in CrossOver, our Monday and Thursday morning Growth Groups. This enables the mums to have a time of encouragement from God's word and pray with other women, without interruption.

Responsibilities include:

- Working with the Play-Pals Team Leader and other volunteers (you are never on your own)
- Supervising and playing with the children
- Helping with morning tea, story and craft times, as required (there is a program)
- Seeking out a child's mother if nappy changing / non-independent toileting is required
- Setting up and packing up toys and other equipment (the space is lovely and well equipped)

Required training:

- Up to date WWCC
- Completed Safe Ministry Training
- Other instruction and training will be available on the job.

Commitment:

- This is a rostered position. You will be asked to arrange to swap with someone else on the roster if you need to make a change.
- Volunteers who can serve regularly bring huge benefit to this ministry but you may choose how often you serve throughout each term
- Monday mornings and/or Thursday mornings, 9:15am – 11:40am, during school terms.
