

Hospitality: Adrenalites Kitchen Helper

Purpose of Role

Central to the Adrenalites program is the children and leaders sharing a meal together. An Adrenalites kitchen helper assists the Adrenalites cooks in the task of washing dishes and cleaning the kitchen following dinner at Adrenalites.

The role in practice

- Arrive at the OEC Ministry Centre following dinner (approximately 7pm).
- Work alongside the Adrenalites cooks to wash-up dishes.
- Work alongside the Adrenalites cooks to leave the kitchen clean, including wiping benches, emptying dishwasher and emptying garbage bins.
- The role is usually completed by 7:30pm.

Required training:

- Highly recommended: Complete the online NSW Food Authority "Food handler basics" training (approximately 1 hour), and provide completion certificate to the OEC office.
- New helpers will be rostered with an experienced cook/helper to provide on the job instruction and training.

Commitment:

- This is a rostered position. Adrenalites kitchen helpers are rostered on once per school term.
- Adrenalites kitchen helpers are rostered through Elvanto. You may submit unavailability in advance and/or organize to swap with someone else on the roster if you need to make a change.
