

Purpose

KidZone seeks to reach out to the children of Orange with the good news of Jesus through a school holiday Kids Club during the Easter school holidays (13-16 April 2026). KidZone caters for children in Kindergarten to Year 6 at school and provides an opportunity for the children of OEC to bring their friends to hear the gospel clearly explained in a fun and engaging way, whilst building connections with the community of Orange.

The roll in practice

The Kids Team works directly with the children attending KidZone. The roll includes:

- Attendance at KidZone team planning and training meetings held during Term 1, 2026.
- Working with a small group of leaders to prepare and run elements of the KidZone program (e.g. games, memory verse activities, Bible talks, crafts, etc).
- Be allocated a small group of children at KidZone to especially get to know, care for, and lead through the KidZone program.

Required training

- An up-to-date WWCC and Safe Ministry Training for all adult leaders.
- Teenage leaders are required to have completed Junior Safe Ministry training.
- Other training will be provided through team meetings.

Commitment

The KidZone Kids Team will need to attend team planning and training meetings during Term 1, 2026 in the lead-up to KidZone. Some preparation time will be required before KidZone to prepare elements of the program that you volunteer to lead. Whilst most leaders will attend KidZone for the full 4 days of the program, there is some flexibility for some team members to attend part-time.
