



Children and Youth: SRE Teacher

Purpose of Role

Primary SRE teaching is a wonderful ministry that seeks to share the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection with the kids in a classroom or assembly style setting. This is a unique opportunity to share the gospel with many kids who may not hear this message in any other context.

The role in practice

SRE teaching is a weekly commitment throughout school terms to prepare for the lesson from the approved curriculum and deliver it in the classroom. The SRE teacher supports school rules and ensures good communication with the classroom teacher should there be any difficult issues with the children. The SRE teacher attends the meetings held by the SRE committee, who provide essential annual refresher training.

Required Training

- Verified Working with Children Check and completed online Safe Ministry Training (essential prior to starting)
- 7 Modules of training (some exemptions available) related to classroom teaching skills, NSW Department of Education policies and a Bible overview. There is a financial cost for this training. Please let us know if you need help.
- Refresher training (2 hours annually).
