

Children and Youth: SRE Helper

Purpose of Role

Primary SRE teaching is a wonderful ministry that seeks to share the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection with the kids in a classroom or assembly style setting. This is a unique opportunity to share the gospel with many kids who may not hear this message in any other context.

The role in practice

SRE helping is a weekly commitment throughout school terms to assist the SRE teacher to prepare for the lesson from the approved curriculum and deliver it in the classroom. Tasks could include craft preparation, teaching a memory verse, leading singing or assisting kids with their activities following the bible story.

The SRE helper supports implementing school rules and ensures good communication with the classroom teacher should there be any difficult issues with the children.

The SRE helper attend the meetings held by the SRE committee, who provide essential annual refresher training.

Commitment and training

- Verified Working with Children Check and completed online Safe Ministry Training (essential prior to starting).
- Modules 1 and 7 of SRE specific training related to NSW Department of Education policies for teachers in school.
- Refresher training (2 hours annually)
