

Purpose of Role

A creche helper cares for children aged 1-3 years during our Sunday services (except C@6:30), to allow parents to participate in the main church program without interruption.

The roll in practice

- Working together with one or more other volunteers
- Setting up and packing up toys and other equipment
- Ensuring children are accurately signed in and out of creche by their parents
- Supervising and playing with the children
- Returning children to their parent if nappy changing / toileting is required

Required training:

- An up-to-date WWCC and Safe Ministry Training for all adult leaders. Teenage leaders are strongly encouraged to complete Junior Safe Ministry training.
- Other instruction and training will be available on the job.

Church@9 Creche Room Leader:

Due to the size of creche at Church@9 there is an additional role of a Creche Room Leader who is rostered on creche for a 2-4-week block to provide consistency for the children, aide in welcoming and settling new children and lead the team of helpers working in creche.

Commitment:

- This is a rostered position. You can discuss with the Creche Team Leader in your congregation how often you serve throughout the term, though this is normally 1-3 times per school term.
- Creche helpers are rostered through Elvanto. You will need to submit any unavailability in advance and organize to swap with someone else on the roster if you need to make a change.
